# Product Overview

This 16PCS camping cooking set is designed for outdoor activities such as camping, hiking, backpacking, and picnics, suitable for 2-3 people. It includes essential cookware and tableware with a nested structure for easy carrying and storage.

## Usage Instructions

### 1. Setup & Cooking

- **Pot & Pan:** Place the pot or pan on a stable heat source (e.g., camping stove, charcoal grill). Ensure the heat source is placed on a flat, non-flammable surface.
- **Hanging Pot:** Use the pot's hanging feature to suspend it over a campfire (maintain a safe distance of at least 15cm from the flame to prevent overheating).
- **Kettle:** Fill the kettle with water (do not exceed 80% of its capacity to avoid boiling over). Place on the heat source until boiling.
- **Non-stick Pan:** For best results, preheat the pan on low to medium heat before adding oil or food. Avoid using metal utensils that may scratch the non-stick coating.

### 2. Tableware Usage

- Wash plates, spoons, forks, and knives with clean water before first use.
- After use, clean immediately to prevent food residue from hardening.

### 3. Storage & Carrying

- Allow all cookware to cool completely before nesting.
- Disassemble the set, clean and dry each component, then nest them in the order of pot → pan → kettle → lids → tableware.
- Place the nested set into the large carry bag for easy transportation. Use the small storage bags to separate tableware if needed.

## Usage Restrictions

- **Heat Source Limit:** Do not use the cookware on induction cooktops (not induction-compatible).
- **Temperature Limit:** The maximum safe temperature for the anodized aluminum components is 260°C (500°F). Avoid direct contact with open flames for extended periods.
- **Capacity Limit:** Do not fill the pot or kettle beyond 80% of their capacity to prevent overflow when heating.
- **Utensil Restriction:** Only use wooden, silicone, or plastic utensils with the non-stick pan to protect the coating.
- **Not for Microwave:** Do not use any metal components (pot, pan, kettle, utensils) in microwaves.

## Safety Information

- **Burn Hazard:** The cookware and lids will become extremely hot during use. Always use the insulated plastic handles and avoid touching hot surfaces directly. Keep children and pets away from the cooking area.
- **Fire Risk:** Do not use the product near flammable materials (e.g., tents, leaves, gasoline). Ensure proper ventilation when cooking indoors or in enclosed spaces to avoid carbon monoxide buildup.
- **Food Safety:** Wash all tableware and cookware thoroughly before first use. Do not use damaged or cracked components (e.g., scratched non-stick coating, broken plates) as they may affect food safety.
- **Lid Caution:** When removing the lid from a hot pot or pan, tilt it away from your face to avoid scalding from steam.
- **Carry Safety:** Do not carry the set while it contains hot food or liquids. Ensure the carry bag is closed securely to prevent components from falling out during transportation.
- **Cleaning Safety:** Do not clean the cookware immediately after use while it is still hot. Use mild detergent and a soft sponge; avoid abrasive cleaners that may damage the non-stick coating.

## Notes

1. Size information is for reference only. Due to manual measurement, a 1-2cm (0.4-0.8") difference is allowed.
2. The product color displayed in photos may vary slightly due to differences in monitor calibration.

3. This product is intended for outdoor use only. Do not use it for commercial catering purposes.
4. Store the set in a dry, cool place when not in use to prevent rust or damage to the non-stick coating.
